COLLABORATION AGREEMENT

Between

ECOFAWN Society (India)

1-90/A, Bahadurpur, Khasimpur, Basheerabad, Vikarabad, Telangana – 501143, INDIA

And

DMUN Foundation

THIS AGREEMENT

is made and entered into on this 4th day of September, 2025,

BY AND BETWEEN

1. **ECOFAWN Society**, an Indian non-governmental organization, duly incorporated and recognized as an Observer Organization with the United Nations Environment Programme, UNHRC and ECOSOC Consultative Status (hereinafter referred to as “**ECOFAWN**”, which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context, include its successors and permitted assigns),

AND

2. **DMUN Foundation**, an international non-governmental youth-focused organization, duly established under applicable laws (hereinafter referred to as the “**Foundation**”, which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context, include its successors and permitted assigns).

ECOFAWN and the Foundation are hereinafter collectively referred to as the “**Parties**” and individually as a “**Party**”.



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WHEREAS

- ECOFAWN holds consultative and observer privileges with United Nations bodies and is authorized to nominate representatives for participation at UN duty stations;
- The Foundation is engaged in international youth representation, advocacy, and engagement in multilateral processes aligned with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs);
- The Parties desire to enter into this Agreement to define the terms and conditions under which the Foundation shall represent itself under ECOFAWN's accreditation at the United Nations and related events.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Obligations of ECOFAWN

1.1 ECOFAWN shall provide a total of **nine (9)** annual ground passes, with three (3) each for **Geneva, New York, and Vienna**, to designated representatives of the Foundation.

1.2 ECOFAWN shall provide a template authorization letter, duly signed by its Head of Organization, permitting the Foundation to designate individuals for representation under ECOFAWN at United Nations events.

1.3 ECOFAWN shall liaise with the Foundation for the purpose of preparing and submitting all necessary documents and information required by the United Nations for the issuance of passes, and for the facilitation of written and oral statements.

1.4 ECOFAWN may, at its sole discretion and subject to its accreditation entitlements, provide additional ground passes in the future, contingent upon the continuation of a constructive and compliant relationship between the Parties.

1.5 ECOFAWN shall ensure implementation of the foregoing obligations within ten **(10) days** of the execution of this Agreement.

2. Obligations of the Foundation

2.1 The Foundation shall nominate representatives who may also represent the interests of ECOFAWN at relevant sessions or events.

2.2 The Foundation shall ensure that statements made under ECOFAWN's accreditation do not directly or indirectly reference specific countries, individuals, mandate holders, or politically sensitive situations that may compromise ECOFAWN's accreditation.



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2.3 The Foundation shall ensure that all interventions and statements are aligned with the principles of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals and shall not contradict the established positions of ECOFAWN, if applicable.

2.4 The Foundation shall provide ECOFAWN with photographs, recordings, and related advocacy material from events for use in ECOFAWN's internal and external communications.

2.5 The Foundation shall ensure implementation of the foregoing obligations within **ten (10)** days of the execution of this Agreement.

3. Autonomy of Representation

3.1 Notwithstanding Clause 2, the Foundation shall retain independence in preparing interventions, subject always to compliance with the restrictions in Clause 2.2 and 2.3 above.

4. Non-Exclusivity

4.1 This Agreement shall be non-exclusive, and nothing herein shall preclude the Foundation from entering into similar arrangements with other member organizations.

5. Liability

5.1 The Foundation shall not be held liable for any misuse, abuse, or misrepresentation of accreditation, ground passes, or privileges by **ECOFAWN**, its affiliates, or any third parties associated therewith.

6. Confidentiality

6.1 Both Parties agree to maintain confidentiality with respect to internal communications, draft statements, and related documents exchanged pursuant to this Agreement, except where disclosure is expressly authorized in writing by both Parties.

7. Term and Termination

7.1 This Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and remain valid for a period of **one (1) year** unless earlier terminated.

7.2 Either Party may terminate this Agreement upon thirty (30) days' prior written notice in the event of breach, reputational harm, or operational risk arising from the continuation of this collaboration.

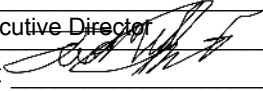
