The DMUN Foundation is a non-governmental organization dedicated to promoting global education, youth engagement, and international cooperation. Through its initiatives, the Foundation seeks to strengthen young people's understanding of diplomacy, peacebuilding, disarmament, and multilateral processes within the United Nations framework.

As this will be the Foundation's first participation in the NPT meetings, the DMUN Foundation wishes to highlight its prior involvement in United Nations-related educational and awareness initiatives, including capacity-building sessions, workshops, and training programmes on disarmament and non-proliferation.

The Foundation continues to work closely with academic institutions and international partners to promote constructive dialogue on global governance and peace education.



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The Foundation has received observer status in the Organisation for the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons (OPCW), the United Nations Convention to Combat Desertification (UNCCD), the Arms Trade Treaty (ATT), the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD), the Convention on Certain Conventional Weapons (CCW), Biological Weapons Convention (BWC), and several other UN System organizations.

The Foundation has also received special accreditation for many high-level conferences, including the Fourth International Conference on Financing for Development, the High-level plenary meeting to commemorate the International Day for the Total Elimination of Nuclear Weapons, the Open-Ended Working Group on Information and Communications Technologies, the UN Ocean Conference, the UN Water Conference, and several other engagements.

The Foundation is also a member of several Major Groups and Other Stakeholder mechanisms mandated by the General Assembly. The Foundation is a member of the Major Group for Children and Youth, Major Group on NGOs, the Civil Society Mechanism for Financing for Development, the Regional Civil Society Engagement Mechanism for the ECE Region, and the Sendai Stakeholder Mechanism.

In this regard, the DMUN Foundation would be grateful if it could be included in the list of participating organizations for the above-mentioned conferences and kindly requests confirmation of its representative's registration.

The Office avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Secretariat of the 2026 Review Conference of the Parties to the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons the assurances of its highest considerations.
