Agenda Item 18: Contribution of the Foundation to ECOFAWN

The Committee on Contributions,

1. *Take Note* of the oral report submitted by the Executive Director on the proposal received by the Foundation from ECOFAWN and the attached correspondence between the Secretariat and ECOFAWN.
2. *Expresses its appreciation* to ECOFAWN for its interest in the Foundation.
3. *Take Note* of the records of the Committee's deliberations on Agenda Item 18 during its 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, 12th, 13th, and 1st Extraordinary Meetings.
4. *Decides* to provide ECOFAWN an earmarked grant of 200 USD to be used for Youth Eco-Club Formation, pending the successful signing of the Memorandum of Agreement and Agreement for Collaboration between the Secretariat of the Foundation.
5. *Commits* to provide ECOFAWN a long-term earmarked grant approximating 400 USD to be used for Youth Eco-Club Formation and Training, pending the successful implementation of the immediate grant provided in Paragraph IV of the current decision.
5. *Inscribes* the agenda item "Review of Contributions to ECOFAWN" for the 2026th Session of the Committee on Contributions.
6. *Requests* the Executive Director to implement the necessary provisions outlined in this decision.
