Resolution Proposed by the Board of Trustees

Expansion of the Mandate of the DMUN Foundation

The Annual Meetings,

Abiding by the Rules of Procedures and the Organization of Work of the Meetings,

Reaffirming the mandates and purposes of the Annual Meetings,

Accepting the decision of the Board of Trustees to propose this resolution for consideration by the Members of the Foundation,

Noting the letter “On Advocacy” submitted by the Executive Director to the Board of Trustees,

Considering the general consensus among Members in favor of the Foundation to expand to activities on multilateral advocacy,

Referring to the original mandate of the Foundation enshrined in the Constitution,

1. *Decides* to expand the Foundation’s mandate to include representation and advocacy in multilateral and intergovernmental institutions on issues of relevance to the mandate and the membership of the Foundation;
2. *Authorizes* the Executive Director, and nominated representatives of the Executive Director, to speak and negotiate on behalf of the Foundation’s membership before said institutions;
3. *Encourages* the Executive Director to apply for requisite accreditation statues at relevant institutions on behalf of the Foundation;
4. *Calls upon* the Executive Director to establish an annual schedule of advocacy engagements, to circulate it to all Members at least sixty (60) days in advance, and to

provide a full report of outcomes and Member contributions at the next Annual General Meeting;

5. *Decides* to review the implementation of this expanded mandate and the accreditation process at the Fourth Session of the Annual Meetings in 2024, with a view to further strengthening the Foundation's capacity to represent its membership effectively.
